



Joint DSBS/FMS Meeting October 2, 2014

Call for Contributions and Pre-announcement

Every second year the Danish and Swedish societies for biopharmaceutical/medical statistics, DSBS and FMS, arrange a joint meeting. The first joint meeting was held 2004 in Malmö. This year's meeting will take place at Hilton Copenhagen Airport on October 2.

The 2014 joint meeting will have a program consisting of 2-3 invited speaker sessions, followed by 4-6 contributing speaker sessions. Each of the contributing sessions is planned to be approximately 30 minutes.

We are happy to announce our first two invited speakers, Professor Stephen Senn, Centre de Recherche Public de la Santé, Luxembourg, and Associate Professor Theis Lange, Section of Biostatistics, Department of Public Health, University of Copenhagen.

Professor Senn will tentatively talk about network meta-analyses and publication of industry trials. Professor Senn was also the main speaker at the first joint DSBS/FMS meeting 2004. Theis Lange will tentatively talk about causality and estimation of direct and indirect effects.

In this first call for contributions we invite you to present at a contributing session. If you are interested, please submit a proposal for title, a short abstract, and the planned length of the presentation to prls@novonordisk.com, as soon as possible, and at the latest May 15. We aim to have the final program for the meeting ready in June.

And please remember to book your calendars for the 2014 joint DSBS/FMS meeting. More information will follow. The conference fee will be approximately 1200/600 DKK for industry/academia employees, and includes lunch and coffee.
